



Summary of achievements 2019/2020

English

- 7 students were entered for the GCSE language examination and the results gained were excellent (1 Grade 4, 2 Grade 3s and 4 Grade 2s) 28.6% of these students exceeded their target grade after an exceptional year's work. All other students met their target grade.
- GCSE spoken language assessments were completed prior to lockdown. 7 students completed this element of the course. They received 2 merits and 5 passes.
- Step up to English was delivered to all other students. 10 students were entered for Step up Gold – 100% of those entered achieved an Entry Level 3. 9 students were entered for Step up Silver – 55.56% achieved an Entry 2 and 44.44% achieved Entry 1.
- Through analysing all English results, 76.89% of all learners entered into English assessments achieved the levels they were predicted.

Maths

- 8 students were entered into GCSE maths this year. The results gained with very pleasing - 1 Grade 5, 1 Grade 4, 2 Grade 3s, 3 Grade 2s and 1 Grade 1s). 100% of students achieved their predicted grades or above.
- In addition to the GCSE, we had many other students entered for Entry level and level 1 functional skills – 6 students achieved a level 1, 11 students achieved Entry 3, and 3 achieved an Entry 2.
- Of those entered 92.6% of students met or exceeded their aspirational targets.

Applied Science

- 100% of students met or exceeded targets in Science with all KS4 students this year completing Level 1 units.
- 12 students completed a BTEC Level 1 award and 6 achieved a Level 1 certificate.

ICT

- 19 students were entered for an ICT functional skills examination across KS4 and KS5 – 15.79% gained Entry 2, 63.16% gained Entry 3, and 21% gained Level 1.
- 4 students also gained a BTEC Level 2 unit award in ITQ. This was the first year that this course was offered to students – the standard of the work produced was excellent.

Personal Progress

- Route 1 and Route 2 students achieved excellently with this qualification – 13 students gained a BTEC Entry Level 1 Award, 9 gained an Entry Level 1 Certificate and for the first time one of our students left with an Entry Level 1 Diploma. Outstanding progress has been made by many of these students and we are extremely proud for one of our students to gain a BTEC Diploma.

- **Vocational and Personal Development Courses**

- Home Cooking Skills - 13 Post 16 students (6 of which are leavers) achieved a BTEC in Home Cooking Skills. 7 students gained a BTEC Level 2 and 6 students achieved a BTEC Level 1
- NCFE Radio This year 8 students across KS4 and 5 have achieved a Level 1 award. We are continuing to develop our radio station to support this qualification further.
- Motor Vehicle Studies – 11 KS4/5 students completed Entry Level 3 Pathway units in this subject passing at least two units.
- NCFE Cookery – 100% of students (11 students) have successfully achieved a 30GLH occupational studies awards at Level 1.
- Land-based Studies – 8 students achieved a Level 1 BTEC Award and 3 gained a Level certificate. A good number of leavers have continued this subject at Rodbaston or Reaseheath college.
- Performing Arts – 100% of students studying this subject successfully completed the units studied. 6 students achieved a BTEC Level 1 Award. 4 students also gain a pass in their Introduction to Performing Arts course.
- Art and Design – 2 BTEC Level 1 Awards and 2 BTEC level 1 Certificates achieved. A further 7 students worked hard to pass the unit of work that will contribute to their award next year.
- Personal and Social Development – 21 Post 16 students gained a BTEC in PSD. 11 of these were at Level 1 and 10 were at Entry Level 3. Many other students completed units towards their full qualification next year.
- Humanities – 100% of students in year 10 and 11 studying humanities successfully completed their entry level unit.
- Work Skills – 11 students have this year achieved a Level 1 BTEC in PSD.

All of these qualifications demonstrated the hard work and effort that all of our students and staff have shown. We are very proud of them all.
